

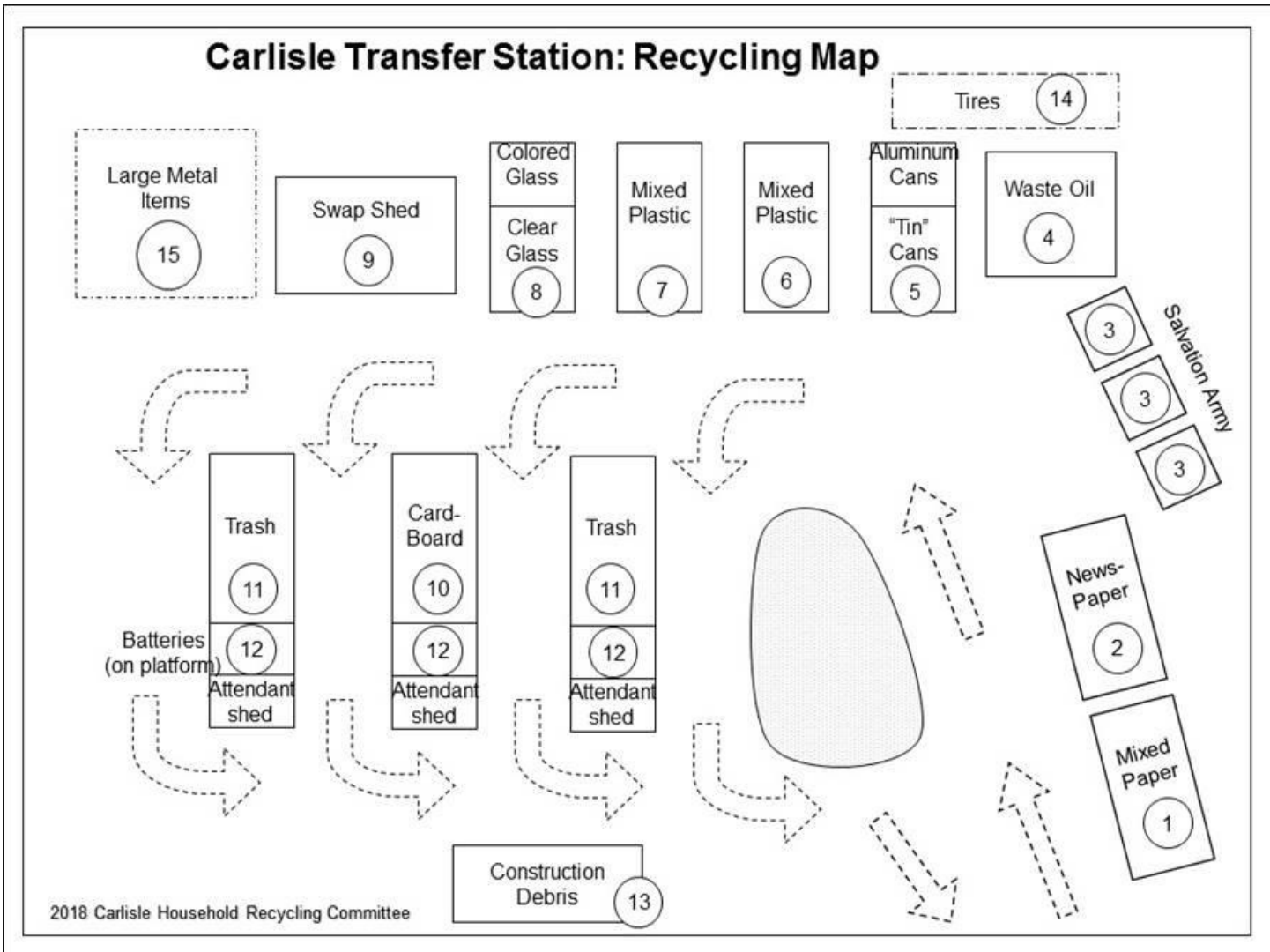

MATERIAL	RECYCLING / DISPOSAL
Cell Phones	Bring to Gleason Library or Verizon store
Eyeglasses	Leave in collection bin at Gleason Library
Hazardous Materials:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oil based paints, stains, thinners & strippers, solvents & varnishes, adhesives, glues, resins, waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline), engine degreasers, brake fluids, poisons, cleaners, spot removers, pool chemicals, aerosol cans, pesticides, herbicides, creosote, moth balls, antifreeze, mercury switches 	Bring to annual Hazardous Waste Day in the spring at the Carlisle DPW (behind the Transfer Station)
Ink Jet Cartridges	Return to Staples for credit
Laser Toner Cartridges	Return to vendor
Medicines, Prescription	Bring to Police Station for disposal (Pills only. No liquids or sharps.)
Mercury Thermometers, Thermostats	Bring to Town Hall (Board of Health); or leave with Transfer Station attendant
Plastic Bags	Bring to supermarket for re-use. [Not allowed in Transfer Station's Mixed Plastic bin, even with a number]
Styrofoam (Foam PolyStyrene #6):	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blocks 	Dispose with trash
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Peanuts 	Bring to UPS Store for reuse
