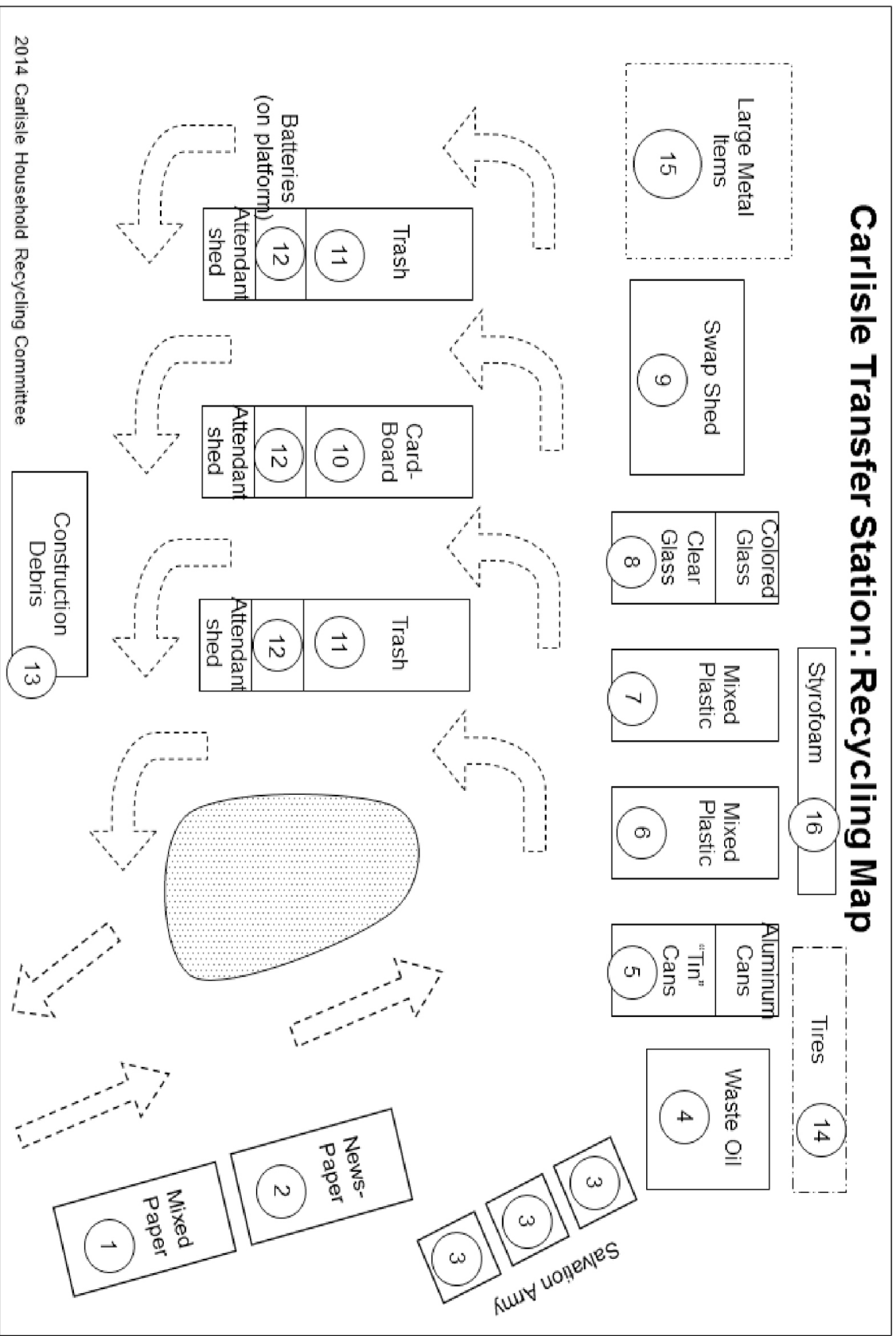

Cardboard	Clean; corrugated, cereal and shoe boxes ("chipboard"), egg cartons	No waxed cardboard (i.e., milk cartons)	10
Cartons (waxed cardboard)	Gable-top: Milk, Juice, Cream, etc.; Clean		6 or 7 (Mixed Plastic)
Clothing	Also small reusable items		3
Computers, TVs, Electronics	Broken OK		9 (Swap shed)
Construction Debris	Asphalt shingles, sheet rock, plywood, lumber, metal fencing, etc.	No paint	13
Fluorescent Light Bulbs	Tubular or Compact (CFLs)		Hand to attendant
Glass	Clean; labels OK	No window glass, drinking glasses, mirrors, or china	
• Clear		No lids; no colored or tinted glass	8 front
• Colored, tinted		No lids	8 rear
Mercury	Thermometers, switches, etc.		Hand to attendant
Metal Cans:	Clean; labels OK		
• Steel	"Tin" cans, lids (magnetic)		5 front

• Aluminum	Cans, pie pans(non-magnetic)		5 rear
Metal Items (Large)	Major appliances, scrap metal, bicycles, furniture		15
Oil	Auto engine oil, transmission oil	No gasoline, antifreeze, paint, or brake fluid	4 (ask attendant to unlock)
Paper:			
• Newspaper	Clean, dry, in brown paper bags	No dirty paper or paper in plastic bags.	2
• Mixed paper	Clean office paper, junk mail, magazines, books, paper bags, window envelopes	No wax paper, carbon paper, towels or plates; no plastic bags	1
Plastic:			
• Translucent milk / water jugs (#2 HDPE)	Clean and flatten; labels OK	No lids or rings	6 or 7
• Mixed plastic (#1-#7)	Clean; labels OK, Opaque (white) jugs OK	No plastic bags (even with a #); no Styrofoam; no lids, toys, or utensils.	6 or 7
Reusable Items	(too good to be thrown away)		9 (Swap shed)
Styrofoam (Foam PolyStyrene #6)	NO LONGER ACCEPTED (as of 10/16)

Trash	Non-recyclables (4 foot lengths max.)	No paint	11

MATERIAL	RECYCLING / DISPOSAL
Hazardous Materials:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oil based paints, stains, thinners & strippers, solvents & varnishes, adhesives, glues, resins, waste fuels (kerosene, gasoline), engine degreasers, brake fluids, poisons, cleaners, spot removers, pool chemicals, aerosol cans, pesticides, herbicides, creosote, moth balls, antifreeze, mercury switches 	<p align="center">Bring to Semi-Annual Hazardous Waste Day</p>
Ink Jet Cartridges	Bring to School office for recycling
Medicines, Prescription	Dispose of in trash. Plastic bottle can be recycled in mixed plastic bin if numbered 1-7
Mercury Thermometers	Bring to Town Hall (Board of Health) to exchange for a new digital one; or leave with Transfer Station attendant
Plastic Bags	Bring to supermarket for re-use. [Not allowed in Mixed Plastic bin, even with a number]
Styrofoam (Foam PolyStyrene #6):	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Peanuts 	Bring to “UPS Store” or “Mailboxes Etc.” for reuse
Yard Waste And Leaves; Kitchen Scraps	Please compost at home
