## Notice of Public hearing

Pursuant to Mass. General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public hearing on February 18, 2021, at 7:30 pm on a Notice of Intent filed by Alison V. Pascarelli & Elizabeth Hudson Valentine c/o Choate, Hall & Stewart for construction of a Common Driveway to serve four lots, including an infiltration trench preceded by a gravel diaphragm and grass strip to control runoff from the length of the driveway, a tee turnaround located at the end of each branch of the common driveway to allow safe access and egress for emergency vehicles, 449 sf of alteration to Bordering Vegetated Wetland to cross a wetland; a portion of the driveway is proposed in the outer 100' of the 200' Riverfront Area including associated grading and tree removal at Acton St. Map 17 Parcel 24-2, 3, 4, 5. A portion of the work will occur within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only - Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Carlisle Conservation Commission will be conducted via remote participation. The public may participate in this meeting via Remote Participation: A website for the meeting will be provided on the Conservation Agenda posted on the Town's website at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
