Notice of Public Meeting

Pursuant to Mass. General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Carlisle Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Carlisle Conservation Commission will hold a Public Meeting on March 30, 2023, at 8:00 pm on a Request for Determination of Applicability filed by Bryan Duby to clear a 10-foot wide path of vegetation within the 100-foot Buffer Zone, north of the onsite Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW) and cross the BVW with an excavator near WFs GC C-13 and GC B34 to perform access for soil testing. A combination of plywood and felled, small diameter trees are proposed to be laid across the wetland during the crossing at 0 Bingham Road Map 16 Parcel 42 Lot 5.

Public Participation will be via Virtual Means Only. The public may participate in this meeting via Remote Participation: A website for the meeting will be provided on the Conservation Agenda posted on the Town's website at least 48 hours prior to the meeting.
