Dear Senior Resident:

A re-emergence of COVID-19 in the fall could coincide with the flu season, so it is very important to protect yourself against the flu this year. The Annual Senior (65 and older) Flu Clinic will be a Drive Thru Clinic on **Friday, October 2, from 10-12 in the St. Irene's parking lot off East Street**. The Clinic will be run by nurses from Emerson Home Care with the assistance of local volunteers. Strict COVID prevention protocols have been established to keep everyone safe and healthy. You will be able to receive your flu shot without leaving your vehicle. Please do not show up if you have any symptom of illness.

You will need to register for the Clinic by calling the COA Office at 978-371-2895. We have assigned times alphabetically by Last Name as follows:

A-B 10:00 C-F 10:20 G-H 10:40 I-L 11:00 M-R 11:20 S-Z 11:40

It is important that you arrive at the assigned time to help the clinic run smoothly. There are a limited number of doses. Your receipt of this packet does NOT mean that you are registered.

Please complete the enclosed forms (one for each person) and bring them with you to the Clinic at the assigned time:

- Flu Insurance Information - see sample attached; please provide the insurance info you provide your physician. If you aren't sure, write "over" and provide the info on your other insurances on the back of the form so Emerson will bill the correct carrier.
- Privacy Notice/Consent to Treat & Disclose – sign and date
- Vaccine Information Sheet - this page is for you to keep.

We ask that you:

- Enter the lower parking lot on the entrance closest to Billerica
- Arrive promptly at the appointed time with your paperwork
- Stay in your car at all times
- Wear a short sleeve shirt or loose sleeves
- Wear a mask for the duration of your visit

If you need a ride or assistance filling out the forms, please contact the COA Office. We have a limited number of volunteers who have offered to drive residents to the clinic.

Your cooperation will help to ensure a successful and safe flu clinic.
