

## Recycling - Cardboard

### Acceptable:

Clean, dry cardboard, clean chipboard (cereal, tissue, and similar boxes), toilet paper rolls, etc.

### Not Acceptable:

Greasy pizza box bottoms, waxed gable-top cartons, fast food containers

### How and where to recycle:

Place in cardboard compactor which is the center of the three compactors at the Transfer Station (Location 13)

### Recycling information:

Carlisle earns money for each ton of clean cardboard

95% of cardboard deposited in the compactor at the Transfer Station is recycled.

### Paperboard or Chipboard



Each time we recycle corrugated cardboard, the fibers holding it together get a little bit shorter. The result is the cardboard gets slightly thinner each time we recycle it. When the fibers become too thin to create strong corrugated cardboard, they are then used for a class of cardboard called paperboard. Paperboard or chipboard boxes are used for cereal boxes, cake mix boxes and cases of pop.
