



## Recycling – Electronic Waste

Carlisle does not recycle most electronics – it is strongly recommended that you bring your old electronics (especially computers & printers) to a local retailer who recycles them. An excellent local choice is Staples in Acton which accepts most electronics at no charge and often issues a \$5 or \$ 10 store credit. This is best for both Carlisle and the environment by assuring optimal recycling of these items and removing them from the solid waste stream.

**COMPUTERS, TVs, & ELECTRONICS** – If, for some reason you bring electronics to the Transfer Station small items should be placed in the swap shop and larger items in the designated area outside of the swap shop. Email the Transfer Station Action Committee if you have the items below. We will connect you with a resident who will prepare them for donating to local organizations.

- Working computers (PCs or Macs) less than ten years old.
- Working laser printers (not inkjet) less than ten years old.
- Working mobile devices (Apple or Android) less than five years old.

**CELL PHONES** - Please don't throw them in the trash or leave them in the Swap Shop. If they are not in good working order, bring to Gleason Library or a Best Buy store for safe recycling. If they are in good working order, they might be repurposed.

- Working computers (PCs or Macs) less than ten years old.
- Working laser printers (not inkjet) less than ten years old.
- Working mobile devices (Apple or Android) less than five years old.

**Electronic Media and Accessories** - Please bring your old media, cables, small electronic devices to the Swap Shop and place in the marked section.
