

Recycling – Cell Phones

Cell phones contain a number of heavy metals and toxic chemicals and disposing of them by the same process as regular household waste has raised concerns over soil contamination and water pollution. Additionally, they contain precious metals and plastics that can be recycled. **The Transfer Station does not collect used cell phones.**

How and where to recycle:

Staples and Best Buy (at its recycling kiosk) accept cell phones at no charge. The cell phones will be electronically wiped clean.

Recycling information:

A used phone can be refurbished and reused or, if it cannot be reused, material components of the phone may be e-recycled and used again and not put in a landfill.
