Proposed Amendments to the
Carlisle Conservation Land Rules and Regulations

The Carlisle Conservation Commission will conduct a public hearing on three proposed amendments to its Conservation Land Rules and Regulations. The hearing will take place on June 6, 2024 at 8:30 pm. These proposed amendments address: the use of trail bikes on conservation land trails as proposed by the Carlisle Trails Committee, and also the use of drones and of metal detecting devices on Carlisle Conservation Land as proposed by the Land Stewardship Committee.
