Yarina — indigenous music of Andean Ecuador
Carlisle member: Mac Ritchey

Yarina was founded in 1984 by parents José Manuel Cachimuel and Rosa Elena Amaguaña who were motivated by the need to amplify the voices of the indigenous people of Ecuador. The three eldest siblings - Roberto, Manuel, and Rimay (ages 10, 12, and 15 at the time) - were each given a musical role to play in the ensemble. The family knew that, through music, they would be able reach a wider audience and open a vital dialogue regarding human rights and representation.

Today, at eleven siblings strong, the group still leads the way in the world of Ecuadorian music, and Yarina is a household name. Their repertoire of music and poetry includes a wide array of indigenous elements from the northern region of Ecuador (known as Otavalo) and has a unique and long-lasting cultural heritage pre-dating the introduction of European influences.

Their songs of love, community, and social justice feature a variety of traditional Andean instruments, such as the bandolín and charango (small box lutes), rondador/sampoña/pakllas (a variety of South American reed pipes), and kena (end-blown flute). Along with guitar, violin, bass, drums, and vocals, Yarina's music unapologetically radiates into the world as a wash of sonic sunshine. Contact: yarinausic@gmail.com; web: yarinausic.org


Red Velvet Slide — original world beat, pop, rock fusion


