CARLISLE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS

Certain property uses and/or modifications are allowed only through a Special Permit and/or Variance from the Zoning Board of Appeals (“ZBA”). Such uses and/or modifications are outlined in the Carlisle Zoning Bylaws.

All applications to the ZBA must be complete, reviewed, and approved for completeness by the ZBA’s Administrative Assistant.

The applications must be filed with the Administrative Assistant in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 40A and Carlisle ZBA Rules and Regulations Section IV.A. The Administrative Assistant is available to assist.

To apply for Special Permit and/or Variance, involving land and/or structures, please include the following:

1. A recent certified or otherwise authenticated plot plan showing the lot dimensions and physical dimensions of all existing structures and their location relative to the property lines.

2. A plan set of professional quality and stamped by a registered professional engineer or Land Surveyor identifying the owner, the applicant, title reference to most recent deed(s) of record, plan reference to most recent plan of record, and the applicable zoning district(s), and showing:
 - a. The location and dimensions of all existing structures on the lot;
 - b. Zoning district boundary lines and the location of buildings on adjacent lots, when the location of buildings is pertinent;
 - c. The proposed location and dimensions of all proposed structures on the lot;
 - d. The lot setback boundaries with the setback dimensions noted from both the existing and proposed structure(s);
 - e. The height of the proposed structure;
 - f. A table of all dimensional requirements in the Zoning Bylaw applicable to the lot and the structures thereon, listing for each
 - i. The dimensional requirement;
 - ii. The existing condition relative to that requirements; and
 - iii. The proposed condition relative to that requirement.
